Topic: Winter Flying - ice in the air

This Zoom continues our series on Winter Flying. Ron Keil discusses winter flying where there is a threat of icing locally or enroute. Ron is based in Michigan and often has to deal with the threat of winter icing in the Great Lakes region.

He was joined by George Richmond, perhaps the most experienced Comanche trainer around, with comments to expand the discussion.

Topics covered included:

- weather forecasting using the usual channels, ForeFlight and other sources
- flight plan deviations when ice is encountered
- recognition of icing types and their effects
- what icing does to the flight characteristics of a Comanche
- actions to escape
- actions to take when icing is discovered
