After a brief review of the events described in Part 1 (Jan 30 ComancheZOOM), she goes on to talk about their actions after the Comanche disappeared under water, the 911 call made at the last second, help they received from local rescue elements, and the training she got as a pilot for the local Civil Air Patrol (CAP) unit.
