Topic: Intro to DTSB Accident Database - with Dan Gryder

In this ComancheZOOM, Dan Gryder describes the database a nonprofit group has been building for several years called DTSB. Volunteers around the country add to the database which Dan states is more complete than NTSB data. The source is often preliminary NTSB reports and does contain speculation and tentative conclusions that are updated with review.

DTSB.org is owned by a non-profit entity of volunteers around the country who add data with more complete information than NTSB data - data like Who, How old, Medical? The group is creating this database out of concern about waiting 3 years to release basic facts. The data is on GA private flyer flights ONLY - no charter, airline, or military flights.

Virgil Zetterlind then provided a demo, using the new Comanche Sim, of the arrival to Lakeland FL as per the FAA NOTAM. Both he and Dan had a number of comments on portions of the arrival that get pilots in trouble, most notable in the final landing phases.
