Parts sourcing is a crucial area for anyone who is dealing with obtaining or repairing - or even upgrading - a scarce part for an older aircraft. FAA FAR 21.9 provides the ability to install parts that were "Produced by an owner or operator for maintaining or altering that owner or operator's product". This provides a broad scope of authority for owner operators.

Zach Grant is well known in the Comanche community as both a fun presenter and a broad authority on the Comanche. He has helped countless Comanches stay airworthy, thousands of operators to fly more safely, and to fly for less expense. He is an A&P/IA, CFII/ATP, and a senior captain for United Airlines. Along the way he has been an ICS President, a frequent responder for technical questions, and updated and managed the successful Comanche recurrent type training program.
